SC's recent verdict on divorced Muslim women's right to maintenance under S.125 CrPC has not created a new right. Divorced Muslim women always had a right to claim maintenance under S.125CrPC. This right was upheld by a Constitution bench of the Supreme Court in Danial Latifi & Another vs Union of India way back in 2001.

The 1985 Shah Bano judgement (which upheld Muslim woman's right to maintenance after divorce) led to the backlash by some community leaders. In 1986 a new law was enacted – the **Muslim Women (Protection of Rights on Divorce) Act**. Muslim women started opting for the 1986 law as it provided full and final
